Treasurer's report: Report given by Josh Callahan. From Fun Night we raised about the same amount of money as last year. We profited around \$1,000. However the day of Fun Night we had to spend around \$600 to buy pop, chips and desserts due to not receiving very many donations from our families. If we wouldn't have went to the store to buy more pop, chips and desserts we wouldn't have had enough for the games and meal.

Principal's report: Everything is great at school. Spring parent teacher conferences is February 23rd from 3:30-8:00. You will receive a message from your child's teacher if they feel like they need to have a PT conference.

Teacher feedback:

- Volleyballs were delivered to 3rd-5th grade classrooms and the students loved them. We are still waiting to see the layout of the new school to see if we could install a volleyball net somewhere.
- 2nd Grade Field Trip Request – 2nd Grade requested that Home and School pay for them to go to Rolling Hills Zoo in Salina on May 11th. The admission fee and lunch fee total is \$1,086. This field trip was approved by Home and School.
- 3rd Grade Field Trip Request – 3rd Grade requested that Home and School pay for them to go to Up N Rollin Skate Center in Great Bend on May 16, 2023. The total fee for this is \$402. A check was made out and mailed to Up N Rollin Skate Center for \$201 to be used as a deposit to reserve the date. This field trip was approved by Home and School.
- The Home and School Teacher Reps will remind all staff at Roosevelt that they need to be using their gift cards and turn in receipts by May 1st.
- Literacy Reading Night – will be held on April 13th. The planning committee is getting quotes for the hot dogs and cookies for the event.

Upcoming Events/Committee Reports/Continuing Business:

- Yearbook – the cover for the yearbook was sent to the company. Staci is still working with Shutterfly on the digital upload option for the teachers so they can submit their pictures for the yearbook.
- Committee Chairs/Co-Chairs – will need more parents to step up and help volunteer. Suzanna is going to work on creating a sign-up genius form where parents can sign-up if they are interested in helping with a certain committee.
- Fun Night Feedback – We had 477 people come through for the meal. The kitchen ended up getting enough volunteers to help in there so they were good. There are still a few more raffle items in the office that parents need to pick up but they have all been contacted.
- Cash Bash – The winning tickets will be drawn April 17th – April 28th. The drawing will be posted on Facebook. 5th grade students will make a video with information about the cash bash to share with Roosevelt students and families to get them excited. The student that sells each winning ticket will also get a prize. The student that sold the \$2,500 ticket will get to pick from the following: bike, airpods, scooter, Nintendo switch lite or \$200 walmart gift card. The student that sold the \$1,000 ticket will get to pick from the following: RC truck, hoverboard, lego set, LOL set or \$100 Walmart gift card. The student that sells the \$500 ticket gets \$25 cash. Each student that sells 10 or more tickets by March 7th will receive a snoball at school. The money must be returned with the ticket stub to school by the deadline to receive the snoball. The tickets are \$10 each and only 2,000 tickets will be sold. All of the proceeds will directly benefit the students and staff at Roosevelt.
- Fun Day – This year we will go back to Roosevelt parents working the games at Fun Day. A sign-up genius form will be sent to parents so they can sign-up to help with set-up, tear-down, games in the morning for 3rd-5th grade students and

also games in the afternoon for K-2nd grade students. Any parent that helps volunteer on Fun Day will have the option to eat lunch at school with their child and Home & School will pay for their lunch.

- 5th Grade Recognition – 5th grade teachers sent a message to all 5th grade parents on SeeSaw to get volunteers to help with 5th grade recognition. The 5th grade recognition committee chairs, Chandra Walter and Katie Joy, will contact the parents to set up a time to meet and start planning.
- Back to School Bash – Hays Rec contacted Lynn to discuss policy changes at the Aquatic Park. Due to the policy change and restrictions, Home and School along with Roosevelt staff have decided to not have the back to school bash at the Aquatic Park. For the 2023-2024 school year, Home and School will host a Root Beer Bash at Roosevelt on the playground. The staff at Roosevelt will be there and have their class roster list so the students can meet their teacher. Roosevelt staff will pick a date that works best for them in August and announce it to parents at a later date.
